

GECA President's Message – 2025 AGM

Please join us for the GlenEagles Community Association AGM on **Tuesday, May 12, 2026 at 7:00 PM** at the Links of GlenEagles (doors open at 6:30 PM). The AGM is your opportunity to stay informed, ask questions, and connect with your Board and neighbours. The meeting will run until approximately 8:30 PM, followed by a casual social with appetizers and refreshments (cash bar available).

Board Elections – A Positive and Exciting Milestone

This year, we have a minimum of **12 candidates running for 9 Board positions**. Nominations from the floor will also be accepted. Ballots will be distributed at the door and voting will take place during the meeting. As residents you have a direct say in who represents the community, and we encourage you to review the candidate profiles in advance so you can make an informed decision.

This level of interest is very encouraging. When I attended my first AGM in 2018, there was uncertainty about whether we would have enough Board members to continue. Seeing multiple residents now stepping forward reflects the strength and growing engagement of our community.

Landscaping Highlights

2025 marked Year 2 of our 5-year landscaping plan, with a continued focus on sustainable, low-water solutions developed in partnership with the Town. Highlights include:

- Maintenance of boulevard entrances and Highway 1A entry
- Improvements to Murphy Brothers Park, Fenton Park, and GlenEagles East islands
- 35+ new trees and shrubs planted on The Landing Island
- New playground at Wearmouth Park
- Pathway upgrades along the golf course ravine

Financial Snapshot

GECA remains in a strong financial position, with the majority of spending focused on maintaining and enhancing our shared green spaces. Full financial statements are included in the AGM package.

Looking Ahead

We will provide updates on several important issues that will shape our community in the year ahead, including the proposed concrete batch plant, the recent sale of the Jones Estate property, and 2026 landscaping priorities.
